



Ever since Merit Academy opened our doors in the Fall of 2021, our mighty school has made great strides in our academic growth and performance.


FOR TWO YEARS RUNNING, MERIT ACADEMY WAS RECOGNIZED WITH THE TOP PERFORMANCE RATINGS OF <u>DISTINCTION</u> FROM CDE.

Out of 1,387 CO schools, Merit Academy ranks 301 (top 21% in the State), which is also the highest academic rank within the four-district area.

This is a tremendous catapult in ranking from 560 in 22-23 to 301 in our third year (2023-34)







SUCCESS STORIES

Merit Academy provides a classical education that is intensive and purposeful. There is pride in being a Merit Academy Bear, because excellence is a standard and students learn "they can." Staff are diligent in their supports for students, to encourage growth and achieve the exceptional. Students learn that the effort they put in today leads to the results and accomplishments of tomorrow.



The following are spotlights of exceptional growth and achievement. These stories of learning and academic advances are not so much the exception as they are the norm.

4TH GRADER'S 1NCREASE IN MATH 35%-85%

A first-grader came to Merit Academy in the fall of 2022 scoring in the bottom 2% on the national NWEA Reading assessment compared to other 1st graders. At the end of his second year at Merit Academy, his score had climbed to the top 75% in the nation, compared to other 2nd graders.

CLASS AVERAGE 18%-76%
COMPOSITE INCREASE

At the beginning of the year, only 38% of 7th graders scored as proficient (met/exceeded expectations) on Math. At the end of the year, over 62% of 7th graders met or exceeded math proficiency.

A fourth-grader came to Merit Academy in the fall of 2023 scoring in the bottom 35% on the national NWEA Math assessment compared to other 4th graders. At the end of the year, his score climbed to the top 85% in the nation.

2%-75% 2ND GRADER'S INCREASE IN READING

In August, only 18% of the entire Kindergarten grade scored proficient in Math and Reading's beginning of the year benchmark. At the end of the school year, over 76% of our Kindergarteners scored as proficient or higher on the end of year benchmark.

SCHOOL OF GRAMMAR EVENT DAYS

Our staff provide students with a learning experience like no other. In conjunction with the intensive classical curriculum, Merit Academy students experience event days that correspond to domains of their classes. We host Renaissance Festivals, Merit Academy Medical Center, Vikings Day, Kings & Queens Day, 100's Day, Ancient Civilizations, and more.







While academic focus is first and foremost, it is imperative that students also engaage in activities that promote character, resilience, responsibility, and a sense of belonging. Athletic programs are essential to this well-rounded education. Students take pride in their school and their teammates when they are a part of something bigger than themselves. We will continue to add popular, competitive sports for our student-athletes.

ATHLETICS SHOWCASE



Woodland Park's HS State swim team was primarily weighted with Merit Academy students: Kensley Pekron (Soph.) ranked top 15 in the 200 Free and 500 Free; Riley Holsapple (Fresh.): 200 Free, 500 Free); and Ellie Geissler (Soph.): 100 Fly, 100 Back.

Merit Academy's Landsharks program offers track and cross country to K-6 children. This prepares them for our competitive cross country and track teams at the Upper School level.





Not only is 2024 (Fall) the first year of our Cross Country team, it's also the first year of our Varsity Rifle Team. These students are extremely competitive and are on track for a very exciting showing at both regionals and nationals in the spring. We can't wait to showcase their results in 2025.

Our Merit Bears boys basketball teams are off to a tremendous start this season. The heart and competitive drive in these athletes is nothing short of exciting. The SOL (middle school) boys took the championship in their bracket in the league.




